The parcel listed on the enclosed bill is now tax-defaulted. 99% of your neighbors have paid their taxes to the San Francisco community – you have not. Your balance will continue to increase every month until paid in full.

Pay the balance shown or set up a payment plan by **August 31, 2020** to avoid further penalties.

If you were unable to pay your **second installment of 2019-20 property taxes** by the May 15, 2020 deadline because of the COVID-19 crisis, you can submit a request to waive the 10% late penalty and \$45 administrative fee. You may also qualify for longer term relief as part of Executive Order N-61-20 signed by Governor Newsom if you were unable to pay your property taxes for your primary residence or small business.
