



IN LIEU OF BUSINESS REGISTRATION FORM - INSTRUCTIONS

This declaration is required for City Suppliers to determine if you are required to obtain a Business Registration Certificate. If you already have a Business Registration Certificate, proceed to question 12.

Who must obtain a Business Registration Certificate?

San Francisco's Business and Tax Regulations Code requires that every person engaging in business within the City, regardless of whether such person is subject to taxation, must register within 15 days after commencing business within the City.

What is "engaging in business in San Francisco"?

If an entity answers "yes" to any of Items 2-11 on the reverse, it is considered to be "engaging in business" in San Francisco.

A single-member entity (including a single-member limited liability company) treated as a disregarded entity for federal income tax purposes will be disregarded for purposes of the Business Registration requirements. Each such entity will be treated as a sole proprietorship, branch, or division of its owner. The owner of the disregarded entity will be the registrant.

How do I apply for and obtain the certificate?

Download the application form and instructions at sftreasurer.org/registration.

Can I do business with the City without a certificate?

The City can make purchases from businesses only in the following situations:

- The entity conducts business in San Francisco and has registered and possesses a current Business Registration Certificate.
- The entity does not conduct business in San Francisco and has signed and submitted the In Lieu of Business Registration Form.
- The entity is a government agency.
- There is an emergency. Although the City can award the contract, the supplier may be subject to business taxes and required to possess a certificate.

These requirements cover service contracts, construction contracts, and product purchases.

What if I currently "do not conduct business in San Francisco," but would register if I win this bid?

You may answer the questions based on your current status, and you should not register at this time. If winning the bid changes your status from not conducting business in SF to conducting business in SF, you should register with the Office of the Treasurer & Tax Collector.
